

Free advice for homeless

A Hackney law charity has launched a new legal advice service for young victims of homelessness or threatened with homelessness.

Young people aged 16 to 24 will be able to get free specialist advice at Hackney Community Law Centre (HCLC), including how to deal with legal issues such as eviction, making a homeless application to the council, or accessing benefits they may be entitled to.

The youth advice sessions will take place at HCLC, in Lower Clapton Road, every Thursday between 10am and 1pm.
