## ARE YOU 16-24 YEARS OLD WITH HOUSING PROBLEMS?

Hackney Community Law Centre is a community-based free legal advice and representation to people living, working or studying in the London Borough of Hackney.

If you are a young person either with housing problems or in inappropriate accommodation we understand that it can be very difficult to understand your rights regarding accommodation, financial assistance and assistance from your local council.

## HOW CAN WE HELP?

For this reason we have set up a Youth Homelessness Advice Project aimed at helping young people (16-24) with legal advice on issues of homelessness and related problems.

We are pleased to be working together with the Off Centre and Springboard Hackney in a project aimed at being as accessible and approachable as possible.

The advice provided includes, but is not limited to:

- Homeless applications
- Advice and guidance about renting in the private sector
- Claiming benefits
- Accessing support for other related legal problems e.g. immigration, and family problems
- Rent arrears
- Possession
- Assistance from Social Services
