Free legal advice is available for debt-ridden Hackney residents, courtesy of a new Dalston pop-up debt and consumer advice service.

The launch of the service, run by the Hackney Community Law Centre in collaboration with BPP Law School, coincided with National Pro Bono Week, which encourages lawyers throughout the country to put their legal skills to good use.

If a resident's inquiry cannot be dealt with over the phone, an appointment will be made for them with a professional lawyer.
